Thank you for your generosity in supporting our Hurricane Harvey relief efforts. Because of your generosity we sent more than \$10,000 to our Baptist partners in relief and rebuilding efforts.

In addition Roy Joe has brought together a work team of 20 from FBC to go to the Houston area the week of October 29. Our children also are collecting items to send with the group.

Their goal is to collect 1,000 items to benefit the victims and to help with the work. Bring your items to the church by October 25.

Hurricane Harvey offerings received now are being used to help with the supplies and costs of our work teams going to the affected areas. Thank you for your ongoing generosity.

Did you know that each week we designate 11 ½ percent of our tithes and offerings to missions and ministry outside of FBC? Some (6 ½ percent) goes to our Baptist partners and missionaries. Some goes to help provide short-term mission trip scholarships for church members. Some stays in Norman to help with ministries like Sunday Supper, Bikes and Bibles, and Friendship International. Some leaves Norman to support ministry and mission work across the globe through our mission partners. And yes, some will go to support our work in the hurricane impacted regions of south Texas. Thank you to our Community Ministry and Missions Teams as they lead our church in these areas. If you are interested in getting involved with one of these ministry teams, let us know in the church office.

Our high school youth and their families are invited to an informational meeting on Thursday evening, Oct. 19 to learn about our opportunity to serve in Peru next summer. As part of our efforts to provide mission opportunities for our youth, we have been blessed to partner with Operacion San Andres (OSA) by sending a team of youth every third summer. The work of OSA has not only met real physical needs, but also the birth of a church to meet the spiritual needs of that community.
