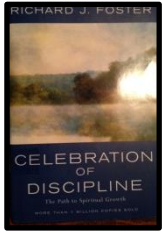

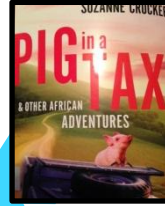
There are three things that amaze me—

Books are like snowflakes... no two the same

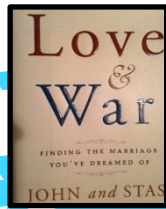


Celebration of Discipline by Richard J. Foster explores the central spiritual practices, or “disciplines,” of the Christian faith.

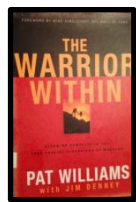
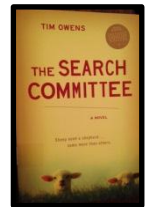


Inspired by her mission work in Africa, *Pig in a Taxi* by Suzanne Crocker contains vignettes about Christian living.

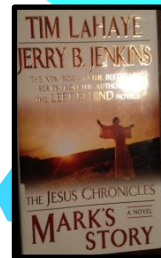
