No scary or witch type costumes and no weapons. All children are invited to attend the entire day (9:05 a.m. -2:00 p.m.) Parents are welcome to join our party. You will find a sign-up sheet at your classroom to help with snacks and treats. We limit the number of treats/snacks in each class, so if you are unable to sign-up at this time, we have other opportunities during the year.
